Planned gifts – gifts from donors’ assets most often made through will bequests – can provide a stream of income to your parish that will help keep it strong now and in the future.

Did you know:

- Studies show that a donor’s annual giving to a charity increases over 75% after making a planned gift – for a parish, this means increased offertory from planned giving donors
- Since FY2017, our parishes have received over \$20.38 million in bequests
- In 2019, bequests to charities totaled \$43.21 billion in the United States
