Interested in certification?

The CDC estimates that each year 48 million people get sick from a foodborne illness, 128,000 are hospitalized, and 3,000 die. The risk of foodborne illness and cross contamination becomes even greater when cooking for large groups, such as school children and families. Food safety workers should become certified in proper food handling.

To assist with this, the Office of Risk Management is offering a **ServSafe Food Manager Certification class** on **January 22, 2022**. The class will be held at the Mission Grammar School in Roxbury. The course is **free of charge** to staff and qualified volunteers, but participants are required to purchase the course materials for **\$75.00**. The course includes the examination required for certification. Please note that **masks will be required** and social distancing will be enforced.
