Sudden cardiac arrest is one of the leading causes of death in the U.S. It can happen to anyone, anytime, at any age. An Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is the only effective treatment for restoring a regular heart rhythm during sudden cardiac arrest and is easy to operate for someone with no medical background.

Because of its life-saving qualities, all parishes should have at least one properly-maintained AED on premises. In addition, we encourage all staff to be trained in CPR and the use of AEDs.

To help, the Office of Risk Management is offering an **AED/CPR Training** on **February 15, 2022**. All parish staff are eligible for training, but space is limited to **two people per parish location**. Because classes are capped at 10 people, training is on a first-come, first-serve basis.
