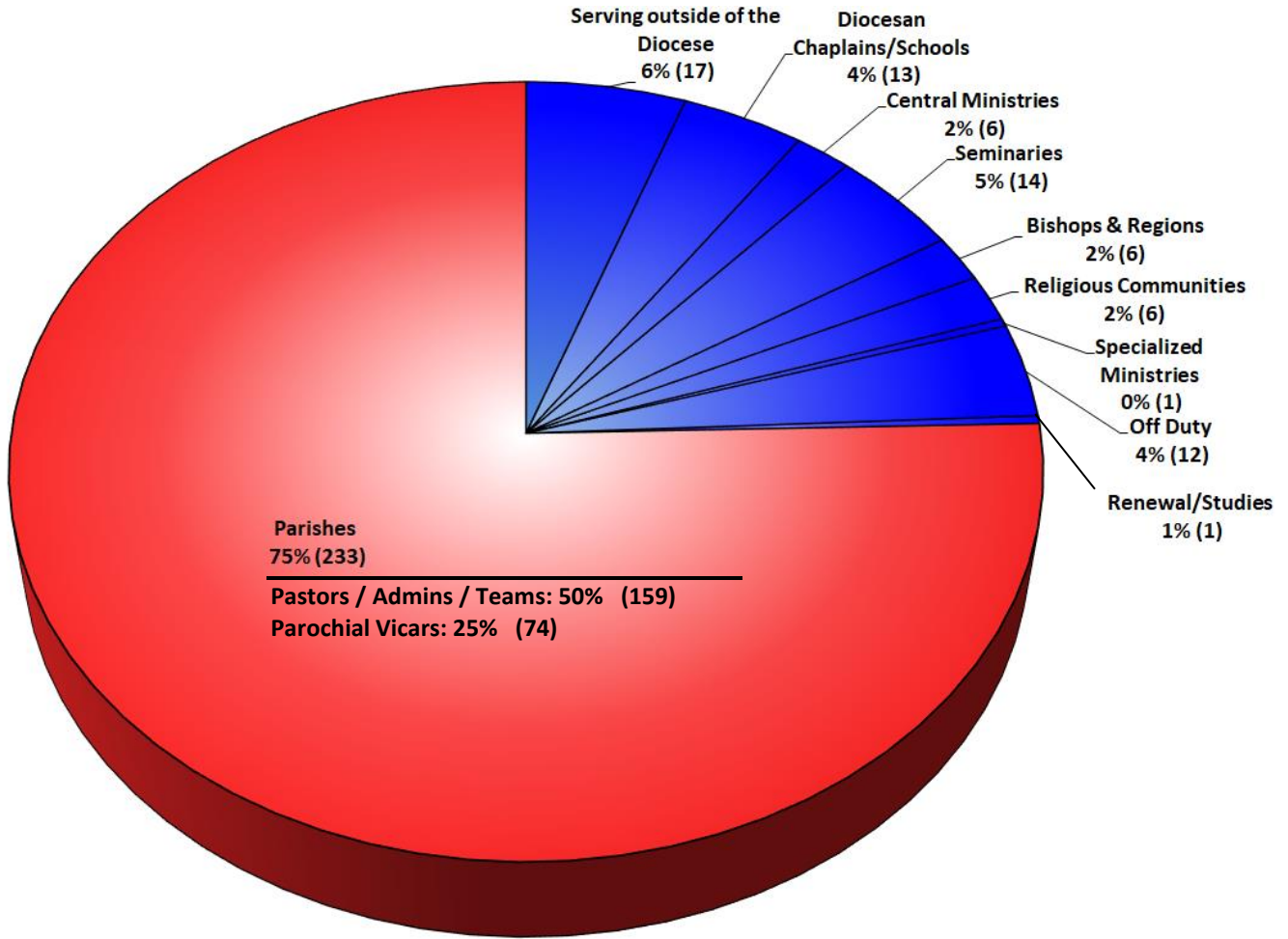
Important Update:

Message from Fr. Bob Blaney - re: 2023 Collaboratives...

Brothers:

Following up on the Presbyteral Convocation on November 9, I am writing to provide an update on the appointment of pastors of parishes in the final phase of Disciples in Mission, as well as other assignments.

I've enclosed a complete list of parishes that are being considered by the Clergy Personnel Board, as well as those that are in the final phase of Disciples in Mission (see below for the list). Any Boston priest is welcome to ask for consideration to one of these parishes/collaboratives. In addition to being discussed by the personnel board, every request made by a priest is brought directly to the Cardinal. In many instances, the current pastor/administrator may in fact be appointed as pastor when the parish(es) begin as a collaborative.

The Personnel Board has been and will continue to meet almost weekly to discuss the needs of the parishes and then make recommendations. Once the board has completed its work, the final recommendations will be presented to the regional bishop/episcopal vicars for their consideration and comments. All of these will be brought to Cardinal Sean. Once he has made his decision, I will be contacting the pastors to inform them, as well as any priest who asked to be considered. I anticipate making calls during March, assuming all goes according to schedule.

New appointments will take effect on June 1, 2023. If for some reason this date does not work, please let me know and we can try to make an adjustment.

Once the pastors of the new collaboratives have been announced, we will then begin the process of parochial vicar assignments, with the goal of having those assignments completed by the end of April. Again, those will begin on June 1.

If there is any priest who feels that the spring of 2023 is a good time for a new assignment, please be in contact with Sean Hickey or myself. We would be most happy to talk with you.
